Even though I haven't found any evidence supporting this idea, the dates work thereby making it a realistic possibility. This interesting possibility shouldn't be conflated and dismissed simply by merging her out of existence.

As is typical of Family Search, I have found myself at war with an individual on Family Search who seems determined to delete these people from existence by merging them together into one person thereby deleting five or six of them from existence because he wants all seven of them to be the Abbess of Faremoutiers simultaneously, which is physically impossible.

For example, at the above link and on Family Search, Sanne is erroneously trying to merge Rothilde de Haudre with Ruodhaid Carolingian into ONE PERSON, so that they both can be the Abbess of Faremoutiers and the mother of Gainfroi.

The obvious problem with this idea is that the daughter of Duke Haudre can't also at the same time be the daughter of Charlemagne. The thing I hate about Family Search is that there is NO guarantee that any of this will be there the next time I go looking for it. It's there now, but things tend to last for a couple of days on Family Search before they are deleted and destroyed once again. Dozens of my ancestors within my Patriarchal line were simply deleted by the admins at Family Search and were gone – husbands and wives. There was no

way to restore them because their records were gone, and no restoration was offered. Furthermore, it did no good to complain to Family Search because it was apparently the admins at Family Search who deleted them.

For every person that they add to Family Search, they should create a MASTER RECORD that can't be deleted nor destroyed by anyone; and, then merge the changes into that MASTER RECORD.

The Fatal Flaw with Family Search is that NO link is secure or dependable. Anyone can delete your ancestry anytime, and there's nothing you can do about it. If you put a link to your ancestors from Family Search into a document like this one, chances are good that your link will be broken the next time you try to use it. If you are lucky you can restore your ancestor by using their Restore feature; but, if the admins at Family Search target you for deletion, then your ancestry is simply gone the next time you try to access it on Family Search. That's not good for the soul.

That's why I finally chose to rebuild my family tree on Ancestry.com where the nutters and crazies at Family Search can't get at it to destroy it. So, here we are:

The nutters and admins on Family Search will continue to delete it and destroy it on Family Search; but, once I have it loaded and saved in Ancestry.com, I should be able to repair it ten times more quickly than I have been able to do before on Family Search.

It will take some work, but I'm determined to get this done right so that it's much harder to delete and destroy on Family Search.

This process of preservation starts with Ruodhaid Carolingian, DAUGHTER of Charlemagne and Madelgarde, another person that the people at Family Search are determined to delete and destroy.

This was the ONLY source I could find that tied her directly to Charlemagne through her mother's line. There's no way to tell for sure if they guessed right or not. Most of the wives need to be researched and corrected on geni.com and Family Search.
